The aim of these Forums is to follow up on the recent *Making It Our Business 2006-2008 (MIOB)* online agency survey feedback which indicated that *MIOB* can be further enhanced.

The Public Sector Workforce Office (PSWO), Department of Premier and Cabinet, with its *MIOB* partner the Department of Aboriginal Affairs will develop an Action Plan to better support *MIOB* to achieve its aims. Feedback from agency surveys and the upcoming consultation forums will help inform the development of this Plan.

Input is sought from Aboriginal employees, their supervisors and human resource managers (various occupations, grades and work locations), to help drive this next stage of *MIOB*. We believe facilitation of best practice examples and information sharing is a key component to further improving better attraction, development and retention outcomes for Aboriginal people in the NSW Public Sector.
